**My Maths: I am good at:** In maths I am good at most things... Such as data handling even though I find one aspect of it hard (blanks on train time tables) I also find times tables easy. **I am working on:** train time tables and reflex angles.

**Miss Trendler says:** Well done ~~Miss~~, you are doing really well in maths and in both shape and space and number. You have shown great maturity and patience as a peer coach / teacher aiding not only your peers but me too with tricky concepts! In KRM you have learnt to add and subtract both whole and decimal numbers with more than 4 digits, interpret negative numbers in context and solve number problems and practical problems using all four number operations. You can multiply numbers with up to 3 digits by two-digit numbers using long multiplication and divide numbers with up to 4 digits by a one-digit number using short division. You have also learnt to add, subtract, compare and order fractions. In shape, space and measure you have converted between different units of metric measure, learnt to calculate the area and perimeter of composite rectilinear shapes and drawn and measured given angles in degrees.

**Your next step is:** To continue to develop higher order thinking and problem solving skills and master train timetable word problems.

**My Literacy:** I absolutely despise literacy even though I'm rather good at it. I have not enjoyed writing any of my story's because we had to write them not type them. But Miss Trendler has said that I can type at least one piece by the end of the year. In literacy I feel we are pressured to write lots of good quality work in a short time space so I can't write my best work.

D.I.R.T'ing your work, checking for errors and up-leveiling what you have done. In writing begin using the perfect form of verbs to mark relationships of time and cause.
